GCEA Annual Report for 2022/2023

1. Introduction

1.1 The Council was elected on 10 August 2022 at the 43rd Annual General Meeting (AGM). It was my great honour to take up the role as the Chairman for the term of 2022/23.



1.2 In 2022, we kept encountering the challenges with the COVID-19 pandemic. In order to safeguard the health of the Council and members, we had no alternative but to keep social distance by minimizing activities and/or shifting the modes from in-person to video conference. Still, 6 Council meetings (by physical meeting, by video conference or by circulation) were held to discuss and administer affairs of our Association.

1.3 Further, the Council has been maintaining close communications with the Grade Management and kept close communications and liaisons with other related associations and institutions for affairs affecting the interests of engineers in the civil service, such as offering views in the "2022 Pay Level Survey – Job Inspection Process for Civil Service Benchmark Jobs" of Assistant Engineer, Engineer and Senior Engineer.

1.4 Last but not the least, the Council had tried our best to keep in touch with members and to receive valuable feedback and suggestions on various civil service issues from them.

4. <u>Collaboration with Others</u>

Liaison Office of Central People's Government in HKSAR

4.1 We have been maintaining close liaison with the Education, Science and Technology Department of the Liaison Office of Central People's Government in HKSAR (中聯辦教育及科技部) and will continue to explore opportunities to broaden our members' understandings of the latest infrastructure, political and economic developments in Mainland China and enhance our collaboration with Mainland professional and academic bodies.

4.2 In 2022/23, we joined the "香港特区政府工程师工会国情研修班" from 5 to 9 December 2022 in Hong Kong together with representatives of the nine (9) other government engineers associations and the HKIEPO ("10+1").
